Program Description: This program prepares students for a career in law enforcement or security. The Utah Collaborative Criminal Justice Associate Degree is a degree presented through the coordinated effort of seven of Utah's institutions of higher education. The courses are offered online; students complete general education requirements either through their home institution or online through the Utah Electronic College.

Admission Requirements: High school diploma or equivalent. Student must choose a "home institution" from one of the participating institutions found online at www.utahcj.org. Student must be admitted to the home institution of choice **and** the program separately.

Graduation Requirements: A minimum of 63 semester Credit Hours (half are in the criminal justice courses) with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 (check with home college to confirm GPA requirements). In addition to the required criminal justice courses, you must complete the general education requirements for an associate degree from your home institution.

Real Time Requirements: None.
