*Program Description:* This degree is designed to prepare students to work as paraeducators in public schools under the direction of certified educators. Paraeducators assist teachers in providing instructional support to K-12 students receiving special services.

*Admission Requirements:* High school diploma or equivalent. Students must contact the advisor before enrolling.

*Graduation Requirements:* A minimum of 18 semester hours with a cumulative grade point average of 2.0 or better.

*Real Time Requirements:* Certain classes require students to observe and participate in K-12 classrooms.

*Delivery Formats Used/Semesters Delivered:* SLCC offers classes online, by videocassette, over EDNET, and broadcast over KULC Channel 9 and its translators across the state. See grid below for details.
