Program Description: This program is designed for students desiring to qualify for positions as information specialists, systems analysts, network managers, information managers, and end-user computing specialists in business and industry. Emphasis is placed on inputting, storing, and retrieving information. Students take classes in accounting, economics, law, marketing, finance, production, computer and computer systems.

Admission Requirements: An associate's degree in an appropriate discipline. Students may need to take pre-specialization business classes, and then apply for advanced standing in the College of Business. Transfer credit or previous coursework must be evaluated before admission is approved. Students wishing to transfer less than 30 credits must submit high school transcripts, ACT/SAT scores, and an admissions application

Graduation Requirements: A minimum of 120 semester credits (40+ upper-division, 60 outside the College of Business) with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 in upper-division classes and 100 credits with "C" or better grades. Fulfill USU general education requirements. Complete 50 percent of required business courses at USU. Achieve unconditional advanced standing in the College of Business.

Real Time Requirements: USU's EDNET and satellite classes require students to attend class at a designated time in one of the university's 80 education centers across the state (for specific locations, see <http://extension.usu.edu/conted/campuses/index.htm>).

Delivery Formats Used/Semesters Delivered: USU offers classes online, by Independent Study and CD ROM, and broadcast on EDNET and satellite to receive sites across the state. See grid below for details.
