Program Description: This program is designed to provide health care practitioners and others with the skills and competencies to function as supervisors and managers in health care settings. The HAS curriculum provides a working foundation in management and interpersonal skills, while at the same time introducing the student to the health care delivery system and its many and varied issues and challenges. Graduates are not only better prepared to assume increased management responsibilities, but to do so with a better understanding of the complex system in which they work.

Admission Requirements: An associate degree in an appropriate discipline. Students may need to take pre-specialization classes, then apply for advanced standing in the College of Health Professions. Transfer credit or previous coursework must be evaluated before admission is approved. Students wishing to transfer less than 30 credits must submit high school transcripts, ACT/SAT scores, and an admissions application.

Graduation Requirements: A minimum of 120 semester credits with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 with a 2.5 or above in major courses. Must fulfill WSU's general education requirements. Students must take at least 30 credits from WSU.

Real Time Requirements: None.
